



BCBS Committee

Chair Appointment & Term:

The BCBS Chair is recommended from the current BCBS chair and is selected from an existing BCBS committee member in active standing. Final chair approval is made by the NCMGMA President. Term of the BCBS chair is 3 year term which can be held for a second term, if approved.

Committee Member Appointment & Term:

The BCBS committee members are selected from various specialty groups that are evenly distributed by the Eastern and Western parts of the State. This committee appointment is for a three year term.

Expectations of BCBS Committee:

This committee is expected to maintain an active participation role and must be present at 75% of the scheduled meetings. You are permitted one teleconference annually. This committee is expected to monitor the NCMGMA listserv for issues involving members and to assist them with contacts for BCBS. This committee also will be responsible for communication via electronic mail prior to any BCBS meetings and or special projects that arise.

Essential Duties of Committee:

1. Represent NCMGMA and its members' interests in the local, state and national BCBS Issues.
2. Act as a Liaison between BCBS and NCMGMA members.
3. Assist with local or regional issues that are requested by NCMGMA members and by engaging NCMGMA advocacy support as needed.
4. Work closely with the NC Medical Society and other state healthcare organizations to lend weight and support of the MGMA membership to assist in resolution of current healthcare payer issues.
5. Provide a quarterly BCBS report for the newsletter.
6. When asked, provide assistance for legislative and current topics of interest for all NCMGMA members.
7. Oversee timely and regular distribution of messages to members.
8. Perform other duties as are necessarily incident to the position of BCBS committee.
