North Carolina Medical Group Management Association Names Jag Gill, ScD, FACHE, FACMPE, 2019 Administrator of the Year

Jag Gill, Chief Executive Officer of Charlotte Eye Ear Nose & Throat Associates P.A. (CEENTA), was named the 2019 NCMGMA/Curi – a Medical Mutual Co. Administrator of the Year during the North Carolina Medical Group Management Association’s Annual Conference awards banquet on Thursday, May 9th. The event was held at the Embassy Suites Riverfront Wilmington hotel in downtown Wilmington, North Carolina.

The Administrator of the Year award honors a medical practice administrator who has demonstrated exceptional leadership and management proficiency, and who has helped enhance the effectiveness of health care delivery in North Carolina. Sponsored by Curi – a Medical Mutual Co., the Administrator of the Year Award also provides the recipient with a stipend for continuing education at a state or national Medical Group Management Association (MGMA) meeting.

Jag Gill has served as the chief executive officer of CEENTA since 2013. Under his leadership, CEENTA has acquired four new practices, opened three new clinics, and has implemented the full suite of Epic, making them the first private practice group to do so in the United States.

“It is apparent Dr. Jag Gill has shown dedication and commitment to the healthcare profession by working not just in the short term, but thinking ahead in the long term, as well.” Said Melissa White, NCMGMA’s Governance Chair and Past President. Gill created CEENTA’s administrative residency program, which allows post-graduate students the opportunity to rotate through several key areas in the business side of health care, participating in core projects that support ongoing department objectives as well as the clinical practice which has been instrumental for creating a positive, long-term culture for CEENTA.

Additionally, he is an advisory board member for the UNCC Master’s in Health Administration program, where he helps mentor those who will lead the health care field throughout the state and country for years to come.

Additional standout achievements and qualities of Gill include steady net revenue growth through his tenure, his collaborative and managerial skills, his desire to create a positive and friendly working environment for employees, and his mentorship of young, up-and-coming health care leaders. All of which landed him a spot on the Charlotte Business Journal’s Most Admired CEOs of 2019.
