ACMPE – American College of Medical Practice Executives

- Certifying body of MGMA
- All certifications (CMPE, FACMPE) are done through the national organization (MGMA), not the State
- State and local organizations are here to help support the certification process
- MGMA.com is best for logistical questions



Eligibility Pathways





Becoming Board Certified

- Purchase and pass multiple-choice exam
- Purchase and pass scenario-based exam*
- Earn 50 continuing education (CE) hours; may be completed up to 3 years prior to application purchase date and onwards
 - Of the 50, 30 must come from MGMA and its affiliates, and of the 30 from MGMA, 12 must be from a LIVE delivery format
 - State and local chapter hours count!
- Board Approval, after all requirements are met. You can complete exams and continuing education in any order.
- Applicants have three years from their application PURCHASE date to complete their Board Certification requirements before needing to reapply.

*Scenario-based exam cannot be purchased or completed until education and experience qualifications are met.

What about those exams?

• Multiple choice exam - 175 items

 Assesses your on-the-job knowledge of the broad scope of group practice management principles and practices as described in the six domains of the BOK.


• Scenario-based exam – 90 items, 18-25 scenarios

- May only be taken once you have logged two years of healthcare experience and earned your Bachelor's degree or 120 hours of college credit.
- Assesses in-depth knowledge of medical practice management principles, problem-solving and decisionmaking skills a candidate would need to handle and resolve real-world medical practice issues.



Scenario-Based Exams

Presented with a scenario Each is a real-life scenario pertaining to the various domains of the BoK 18-25 scenarios per exam form 120 minutes to complete Each form will have 90 items/questions





Register & Schedule Exam(s)

- Can register and sit for exams with as little as 48 hours' notice any time of the year
- Option for on-demand testing at over 500 Meazure Learning testing locations, or
- May select live remote proctored (LRP) format from the location of choice, including home or office
- If taking both exams, must make appointment for 2
- Once purchased, one year to complete
- Within 24 hours of registering, you will receive a "notice to schedule." You will only receive one notice to schedule per exam purchased


Body of Knowledge (BoK)

The complete set of concepts, terms and activities that make up medical practice management.

- Serves as a repository of industry knowledge, a guide to practice management, an assessment of competency and a learning tool
- Serves as a blueprint for those pursuing certification
- Has been around over 65 years!

So, what's it all cost?

Every step along the CMPE pathway involves a financial investment.

- CMPE Nominee status requires an MGMA-national membership (\$399 annually)
- Board Certification (CMPE) application fee to enter into Nominee status: \$250
 - If already an MGMA-national member, a \$100 discount is offered when entering Nominee status
- Each exam (MC and SB) are \$167 (per attempt)
- Study resources: free and paid options available
- Continuing education: free and paid options.

Fellowship—Pathway 1

Complete One or More, Total of at Least 15 Hours

- Business plan*
- Develop or teach University or advanced coursework*
- Completion of industry related Post-Graduate level education programs including Capstones, Master's Thesis, and doctoral dissertation.*
- Formal presentations and speaking engagements at a recognized education event of at least 45 minutes in length as the sole speaker. If cospeaking or a panel, must have contributed at least 45 minutes of content alone.**
- Author or co-author of an industry related book of at least 1,000 words as a contributor.**
- Author articles for industry-respected organizations including, but not limited to MGMA publications of at least 1,000 words in length. If coauthored or featured, must have provided at least 1,000 words of the published work.**

*One submission of this type is automatically tracked for an estimated total of 15 hours **Specifications of acceptable submissions for this type are required



Fellowship—Pathway 2

Certification Validation and Leadership Hours Required

- Must have held CMPE designation for at least 6 years
- Must complete 25 CE hours pertaining to leadership
 - CE hours can be backlogged up to 6 years prior to application purchase date
 - Must be directly related to "leadership development," not general CE or healthcare management
 - Learning new leadership techniques
 - Refine old skills to run a team (assertive communication, motivation methods, coaching, etc.)

Maintain Your Designation

Continuing Education Requirements

Every three (3) years:

- Earn 50 hours of CE
 - -30 of 50 must be from MGMA National, State or local
 - 12 of 30 must be from LIVE learning from MGMA National, State or local
 - The remaining 20 hours can come from other qualified sources
- Fellows must also submit **6** hours of volunteer work, **3** of which must pertain to healthcare
 - ★Bonus—If you volunteer with NCMGMA, those hours count!
